It has tons of packages dealing with advanced and complex analysis specifically for different fields. Due to its flexibility in coding, R is now one of the most popular programs among statisticians and other researchers. This workshop will cover the basics of R package and programming as well as data description and statistical analysis including correlation, regression, t-test, ANOVA, and two-way tables with Chi-square test.	1:00-3:00	Webex

We will cover the underlying statistical assumptions, what happens when they are violated and ways to address those violations, interpreting regression coefficients, and model fit.
