Learning Objectives

To ensure that your first essay is a success, we will examine practices you can use to:

1. **Write topic sentences and body paragraphs (LO 3.1)**
 - Write topic sentences that make arguable claims
 - Organize body paragraphs using the MEAL concept
 2. **Draft an introductory paragraph (LO 3.2)**
 - Organize an introduction using effective rhetoric
 - Develop a working thesis statement
 3. **Construct a conclusion paragraph (LO 3.3)**
 - Synthesize your argument rather than summarize
 - Address the "so what" question

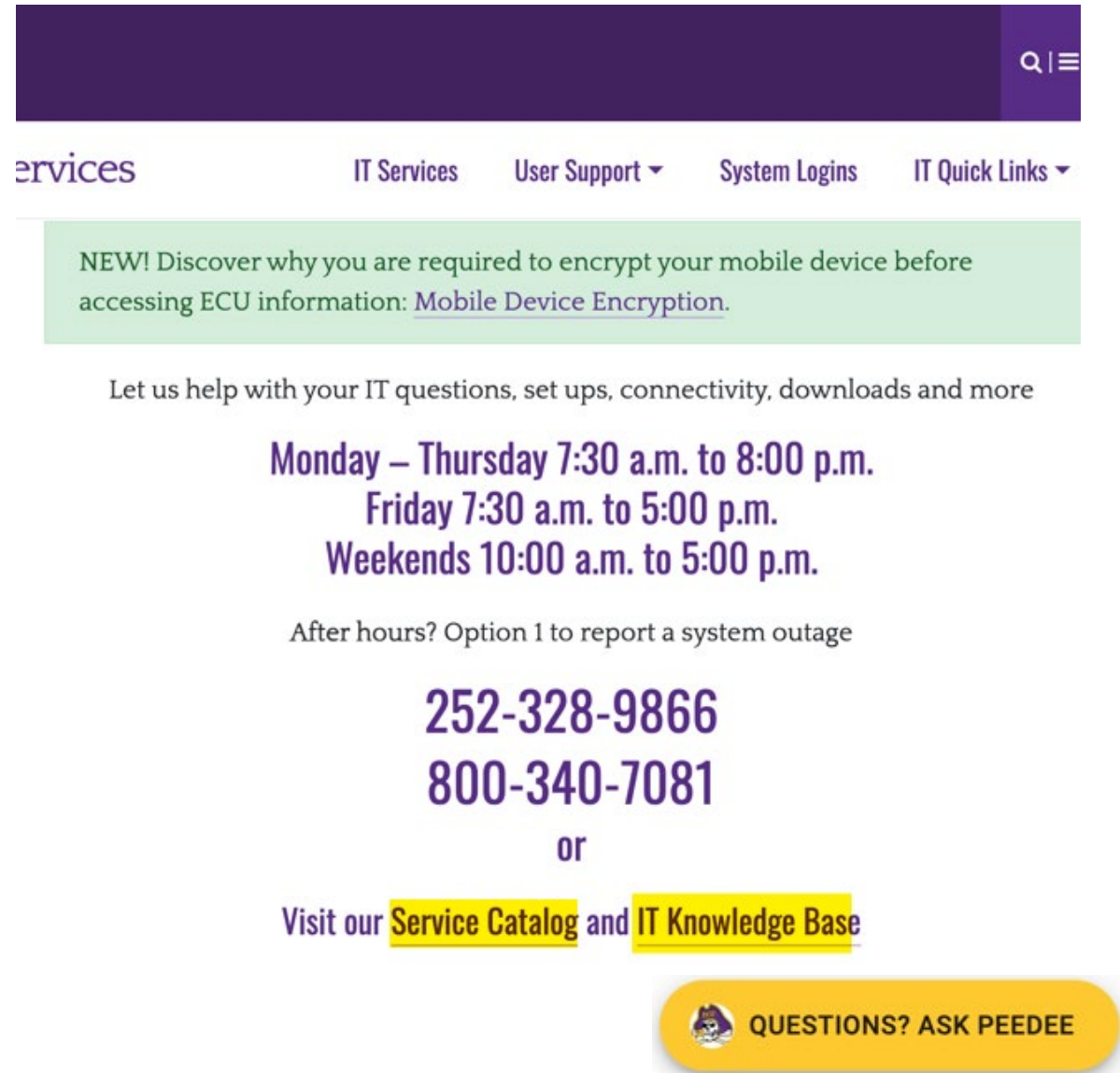
