Laupus Health Sciences Library provides health sciences information, resources, and services for eastern North Carolina with a primary focus on colleges and schools within the Division of Health Sciences.



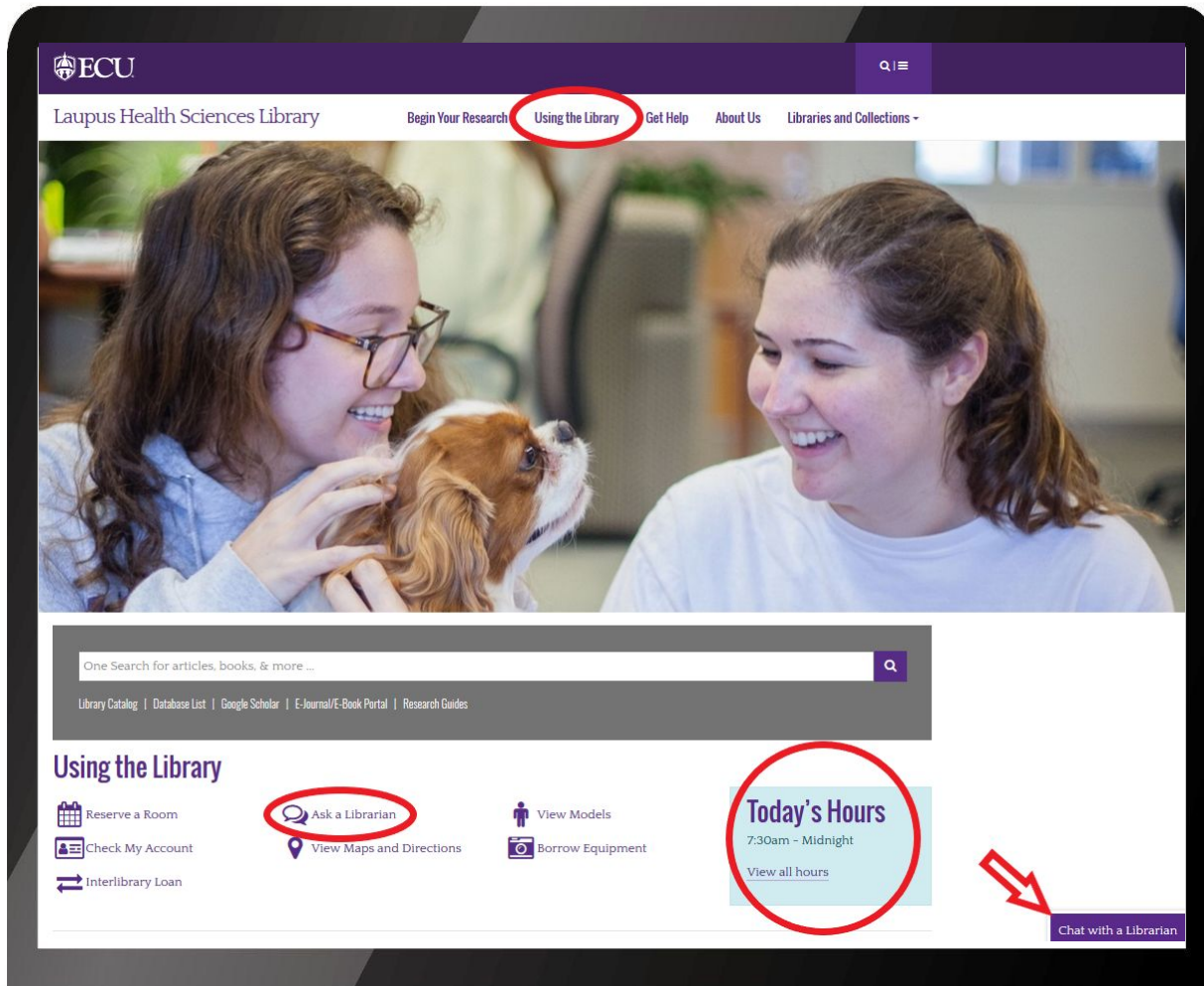
Music Library

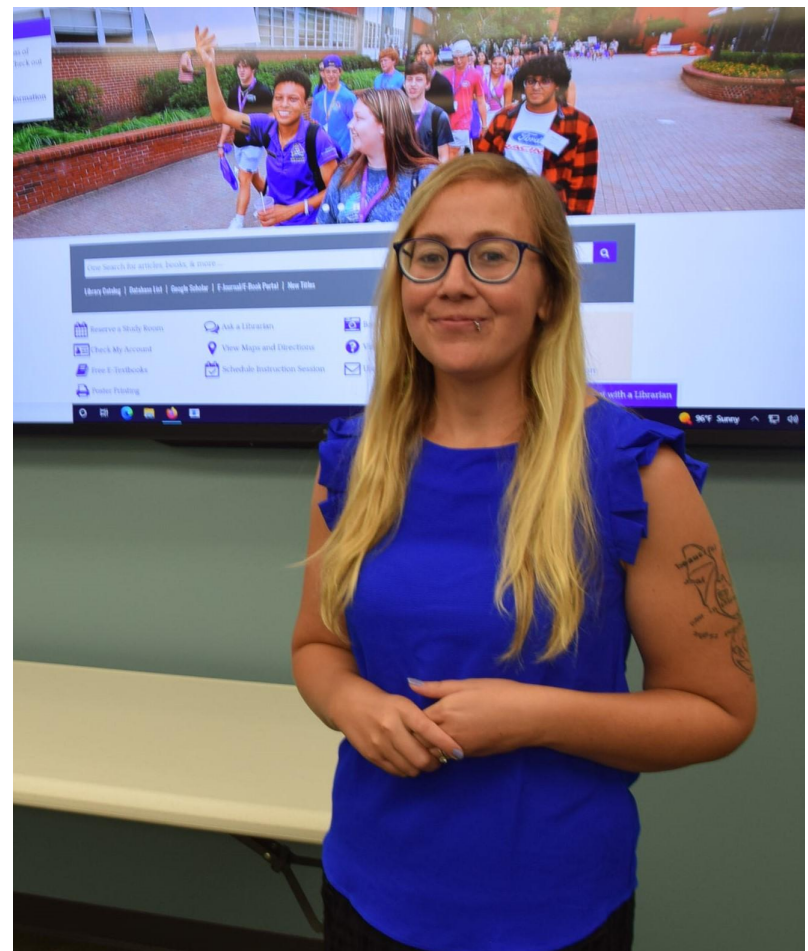

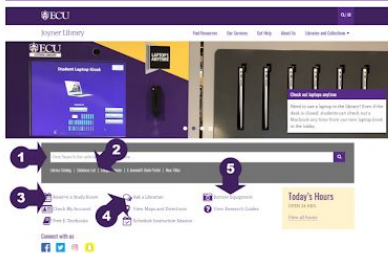

Navigating the Library Homepage



1. One Search will help you locate articles, books, and media for your research projects.
2. Database List gives you access to over 400 library databases, ideal for finding high-quality scholarly articles within your discipline. Databases are categorized by subject area.
3. Reserve a Study Room allows you to reserve individual and group study rooms within Joyner Library.
4. Ask a Librarian will quickly put you in touch with Joyner Library's Research Desk. Let us know how we can assist you with your research.
5. Borrow Equipment. A variety of equipment is available for checkout at the Circulation Desk, from laptops and cameras to calculators and headphones.

Scholarly, Popular, and Trade publications

You may be asked to use "scholarly" or "peer-reviewed" articles for a research-based assignment, or you may want to consult the "trade" literature for information on a particular industry or profession. Understanding the differences between scholarly, trade, and popular sources—and the role each plays in generating and disseminating knowledge—is helpful for conducting college-level research. Communication

- Communication and Mass Media Complete (KMCMC) Journals in communication studies, with coverage extending to the first issue of each.
- ProQuest Research Library General reference database from business and political science to literature and psychology scholarly journals, trade publications, magazines, and daily news content.

Social Sciences

- PsycINFO Includes professional and academic literature in psychology and related disciplines. Great for topics such as interpersonal communications and non-verbal behaviors.
- SocINDEX with Fulltext Comprehensive coverage of sociology, encompassing all sub-disciplines and closely related areas of study, including criminal justice, gender studies, marriage & family, social work, sociological research and many more.

Education

- Education Research Complete Covers scholarly research and information relating to all areas of education.
- ERIC via ProQuest Search here for literature from education and related disciplines. ERIC includes both scholarly and non-scholarly sources.

Arts & Humanities

- Humanities International Complete This is a comprehensive database of journals, books and other important reference sources in the humanities.
- ProQuest Arts & Humanities Full Text This database includes full text coverage of care arts and humanities focused periodicals and books.

Multidisciplinary Databases

Multidisciplinary Databases can be terrific places to find articles for your research projects, and they are likely to include useful information regardless of your topic. Because multidisciplinary databases cover a wide range of research areas, they are often a best, first stop when doing research. Click on the database name below to try one:

- ProQuest Research Library ProQuest Research Library is a truly multidisciplinary resource featuring a diversified mix of scholarly journals, trade publications, magazines, and other timely sources across the top 150 subject areas. By covering more subject areas than other resources, it is ideal for saving diverse needs from the one-time user to the interdisciplinary needs of serious researchers. ProQuest Research Library provides access to a wide range of the core academic titles, from business and the sciences to literature and politics.

Engineering Article Databases -- General

- AccessEngineering[®]**
 A fully searchable collection of texts from standard engineering reference works in the areas of biomedical, chemical, civil, electrical, petroleum, environmental, industrial, mechanical, operations management, and software engineering. Topics include: principles and best practices, code, business skills, communications, operations management. Includes Schaum's Outlines. Formerly, McGraw-Hill Digital Engineering Library.
- Applied Science & Technology Full Text[®]**
 Provides indexing, abstracts, and articles for core journals on technology and applied sciences. Topics include: biomedical engineering, engineering, and construction management among others. Includes full text for some titles. Content spans 1983 - Present.
- IEEE Xplore[®]**
 Provides access to scientific and technical content published by IEEE (Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers) and its publishing partners. Comprised of over four million full text documents. It includes journals, conference reports, technical standards, and books. Covers electrical engineering, computer science, and electronics.

I need a specific (known) journal -- E-Journal Portal

Find Full-Text Articles --When you have a citation to a specific journal and you need to get the full text of an article from it.

E-Journal Portal/E-book Locator -- When you want to just browse an online journal



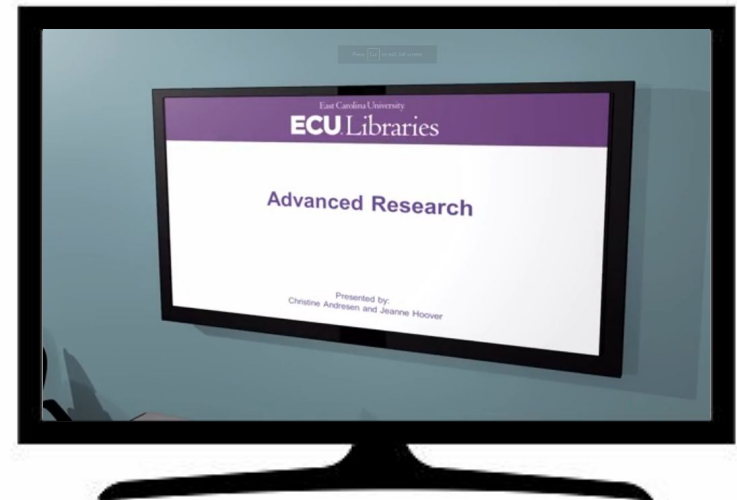

ALS Subject Liaisons

- **Engagement:** Engage with faculty and students in assigned areas in order to facilitate use of library collections and services, and to advocate for their information needs
- **Scholarly Communications:** Keep current with general trends in scholarly communication, monitor subject-specific trends, and provide program-specific support for library initiatives such as sustainable publishing, open access, and open educational resources

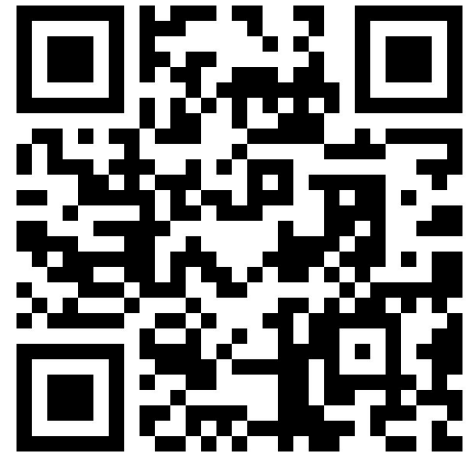
